Miriam Jordan is a First Nation artist, curator and writer currently living in London, Ontario. Her multi-disciplinary artwork has been exhibited both nationally and internationally, including in the touring exhibition *Oh, So Iroquois* (2007-2010) curated by Ryan Rice, and is in the collection of The Woodland Cultural Centre. With Julian Haladyn she curated *The Films and Videos of Jamelie Hassan* (2009-2011), the first program to bring together Hassan's films and videos in a single screening; accompanying this project is a catalogue examining Hassan's use of moving image art forms, which Jordan co-authored.
